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Historical Sketch:

The Florida Citrus Reporter was an independent citrus industry newsletter started by John D. "Jack" Gurnett on January 10, 1940. It provided an in-depth look at the industry and covered a range of topics including legislation, crop conditions, and scientific research relevant to the industry.

In 1968, Gurnett's daughter Nancy Gurnett Hardy took over the role of Editor after his passing. Prior to her taking on the role, Gurnett Hardy had worked on the newsletter since the age of seven. During their respective times as Editor, both also wrote for other publications including local newspapers the *Winter Haven News*

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Provenance Statement:

The Florida Citrus Reporter newsletter collection was donated to the Thomas B. Mack Citrus Archives at an indeterminate time. The Thomas B. Mack Citrus Archives were transferred to the Roux Library in 2005 then to the McKay Archives Center in 2009.

Notes to Researchers:

The collection contains both originals and photocopies of bulletins. Originals bulletins are printed on goldenrod yellow paper.

Please note that Volume and Issue numbers reflect what is printed on the newsletter.

-Dates inside square brackets [MM/DD] indicate the publication date of an issue that shares the same issue number as another.

-In the 1970s, the Weekly Bulletin Volumes ran from the second week of January to the first week of January of the following year. Starting in 1980, however, the Weekly Bulletin volumes ran based on the calendar year (January through December). Furthermore, starting in 2002, the volume numbers appear to reflect the years since the newsletter's inception rather than the year itself.
